I. Background

- A. The Kubota Tractor Company through Lansdowne-Moody is donating a new Kubota SSV 75 loader which includes a hydraulic claw valued at \$39,276 to the City of Galveston.
- B. The Kubota Tractor Company has donated one million dollars to areas damaged by Hurricane Harvey to assist them rebuild their communities.
- C. This new piece of equipment will be assigned to the Parks and Recreation Department.
