



Definitions

CONCESSIONS —

Truck/Trailer/Kiosk; A mobile concession establishment that is self-sufficient and readily moveable

CONCESSION PARK —

Any parcel where two (2) or more concessions gather under a designated park manager.

CONCESSION PARK MANAGER —

A person, corporation or entity that owns or is designated as the responsible party for management of a park and shall be responsible for compliance with all applicable local and State regulations

TRAILER —

A portable vehicular structure built on a chassis, which may or may not be self-propelled being either a dependent or independent unit



Application Process, Documents, and Fees

- [] Submit a written application to the Development Services Department
- [] Provide valid legal identification, as well as proof of insurance and/or bond
- [] Detailed site plan illustrating the proposed concession and its amenities
- [] Galveston County Health Division permit (if required)
- [] Signed copy of the current lease from the property owner where the concession is operating
- [] State sales tax identification number with the City of Galveston being the origin of sales
- [] Statement as to whether or not the applicant has been convicted of any crime or violation
- [] Annual Concessions Fee (Park Manager = \$1,000.00; Individual Vendor = \$500.00)

Approval Standards

- Shall **NOT** Be Permitted Within:
 - 75-ft of existing brick-and-mortar structure selling similar goods;
 - 500-ft of any school structures;
 - Public right-of-way or driveway;
 - Any required parking spaces
 - Concessions shall not operate from a vehicle such as a pickup truck, flatbed trailer, car, or van
 - No cracked windows, visible rust or disrepair, offensive language, etc.
 - Serving windows shall maintain a minimum setback of five (5) feet from street right-of-way
 - Signage: maximum of four (4) signs; One (1) A-Frame not to exceed 6 sq. ft.; Flashing signs are prohibited
 - Must be maintained in a clean and sanitary manner; must be associated with a commissary for disposal of oil and grey water.
 - No more than 12 seats per concession; of which is limited to picnic tables only.
- Penal Clause: any person violating any provision of this article shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
