RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALVESTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, THE DEPUTY CITY MANAGER, THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE, AND THE CONTROLLER TO EXECUTE ALL GRANT DOCUMENTS FOR THE REQUEST OF FUNDS SUBMITTED VIA THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE'S TEXAS INTEGRATED GRANT REPORTING (TIGR) SYSTEM AND APPROVING THE AUTHORIZED DEPOSITORY SIGNATORIES FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - MITIGATION PROGRAM (CDBG-MIT), CONTRACT NO. 22-085-005-D233; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS OF FACT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Galveston, has been awarded grant funds made available from the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) program to provide financial assistance with funds appropriated under the Further Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Requirements Act, 2018 (Public Law 115-123), as appropriated by Congress through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development enacted on February 9, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Texas General Land Office (GLO) requires authorized depository signatories for the City of Galveston in order to release funds through the draw down procedure through the GLO's Texas Integrated Grant Reporting (TIGR) System; and

WHEREAS, an original signed copy of the TX GLO Depository/Authorized Signatories Designation Form is to be submitted with a copy of this Resolution to the GLO; and

WHEREAS, the City of Galveston, Texas acknowledges that in the event that an authorized signatory of the City changes, the City will provide the GLO with a Resolution naming the new authorized signatory, as well as a revised Depository/Authorized Signatories Designation Form.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Galveston deems it in the public's interest to authorize the City Manager, Deputy City Manager, Director of Finance, and the Controller to execute all grant documents for the draw down of funds through the GLO's Texas Integrated Grant Reporting (TIGR) System and approve the authorized depository signatories for the Community Development Block Grant- Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALVESTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The findings and recitations set out in the preamble of this Resolution are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Galveston hereby authorizes the City Manager, Deputy City Manager, the Director of Finance, and the Controller to execute all grant documents for the draw-down of funds through the GLO's Texas Integrated Grant Reporting (TIGR) System and approve the authorized depository signatories for the Community Development Block Grant-Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT).

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of the Resolution severable, and if any phrase clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Resolution be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not be affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be and become effective from and after its adoption.
