I. BACKGROUND

A new Fire Station #1 is under construction at 823 26th street. This facility is slated for completion in mid-May 2019. All GFD operations currently at 2517 Ball will re-locate to the new facility.

II. CURRENT SITUATION

Metro Fire Apparatus and Artic Compressors are collectively donating a new SCBA Air compressor for re-filling SCBA bottles after use.

III. PROPOSAL

The donation will include a 10 h.p. 4 Stage compressor, Fill Station C-FS2C and four Storage Cylinders C-6000-UN. The total value of this donation is **\$ 39,950.00.**
