	1. I have a question about this project that bids on 7/28. Can you tell me where the 4300' of 10" water is on the plans for bid item 56. I do not see it anywhere.	All the water lines in the segment are to be upsized to 12". There should not be any 10" water line to be replaced on the plans. However, this line item has been included in the bid form in case any unforeseen event occurs during construction that will warrant the installation of a 10" line.
	2. Can you please clarify Item #36 . It calls for a LS Traffic Signal Design and Construction, but we did not see any plans for construction of traffic signals in the plan sheets. Can you please tell us what the intent for this item is?	This bid item has been removed from the bid form. Please see revised bid form in appendix A
