## MOBILIZATION

## PART 1 GENERAL

## 1.01 SECTION INCLUDES

- A. Mobilization of construction equipment and facilities onto the site.

## 1.02 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

- A. Unit Price Contracts: If Contract is Unit Price Contract, measurement for mobilization is on a lump sum basis and shall not exceed three (3) percent of the base bid.
- B. Stipulated Price (Lump Sum) Contract. If Contract is Stipulated Price Contract, payment for Work in this Section is included in total Stipulated Price.
- C. Mobilization payments may be included in monthly payment estimates upon written application by Contractor, subject to the following provisions:

1. Authorization for payment of 50 percent of the contract price for mobilization will be made upon receipt and approval by the City or Project Manager of the following items, as applicable:
  - a. Submittal Schedule (Specification Section 01300)
  - b. Schedule of Values (Specification Section 01292)
  - c. Traffic Control Plan, as applicable (Specification Section 01570)
  - d. Trench Safety Program (Specification Section 01526)
  - e. Construction Schedule (Specification Section 01310)
  - f. Construction Photographs (Specification Section 01380)
  - g. Building Permit (for Facility Projects)
  - h. Lease Agreement for Laydown Yard, as applicable (Specification Section 01500)
  - i. Mobilize construction equipment, facilities, and materials to the site or sites.

2. Authorization for payment of the remaining 50 percent of the mobilization will be made upon completion and acceptance of an additional 10% of the project and submittal of invoice reflecting this work to the City contingent on the following:
  - a. Mobilization payments will be subject to retainage amounts stipulated in the General Conditions.
  - b. Only one mobilization shall be paid for projects with multiple locations. Movement within the project shall be incidental.
  - c. De-mobilization costs, including site cleanup and restoration to existing (or better) conditions, are incidental and the Contractor is responsible for de-mobilization from the site in conformance with the requirements of these contract documents.
