Galveston police respond to serious single-vehicle accident on FM 3005

GALVESTON, TX (October 1, 2025) – Galveston police responded to a major accident in the 25000 block of FM 3005 on Tuesday, September 30, at approximately 6:05 p.m.

Galveston's Fire Engine 8 was the first to arrive on scene and reported that one person was entrapped inside the vehicle, while another passenger had been ejected as a result of the crash. A traffic safety officer later confirmed that the injuries sustained may be life-threatening.

The accident involved a single vehicle, a 2006 silver Mazda, which appeared to have struck a traffic barrier while traveling westbound. The vehicle then crossed multiple lanes, veered off the roadway into the grass, and collided with a utility pole, a one-way sign, and a do-not-enter sign.

All westbound lanes of FM 3005 were closed, and traffic was diverted as authorities conducted the investigation.

Both occupants of the vehicle were transported by Galveston EMS to the emergency room at UTMB Galveston for medical treatment.

Charges in the incident are pending the outcome of the ongoing accident investigation.
