



Hurricane Preparedness Plan

For large scale projects greater than 5,000 square feet of ground area or greater than 2 stories

Hurricane Preparedness statement for VE flood zone construction sites

- 1) Submit plans for anchoring systems on all temporary construction structures to include trailers, office buildings, shipping containers, restroom facilities, dumpsters, fencing and any other job site structure to resist lift, floatation and lateral movement due to wind loads and non-hurricane high water events.
- 2) Submit plans for quick-disconnect couplings of electrical and plumbing service to facilitate rapid removal of structures, if necessary. (Electrical and Plumbing permits required)
- 3) Submit timeline plans for the following **pre-storm** phases:
 - A) 72-48 hours before hurricane landfall
 - B) 48-36 hours hurricane watch
 - C) 24 hours hurricane warning

Items to be included in pre-storm plans:

- Submit plan to remove all temporary construction structures to include trailers, office buildings, shipping containers, restroom facilities, dumpsters, fencing and any other structure that could obstruct or divert flow of waves. Include names and contact information of all 3rd-party contractors responsible for removal of such structures.
- Submit 48-hour plan to remove or elevate and secure all construction materials and equipment. (Note: The lowest member of all elevated material or equipment must be elevated to 18 inches above base flood elevation and secured to resist hurricane-force winds.)
- Submit plans for anchoring or removing construction tower cranes for pending hurricane event.
- Submit plans for post storm cleanup of debris and re-installing removed temporary construction structures and equipment.
- Attest that all temporary construction-related containers and equipment will be removed upon completion of the project.
- Any construction container or equipment must be placed within the boundaries of the property where construction is occurring, unless otherwise approved in writing by the adjacent property owner.
