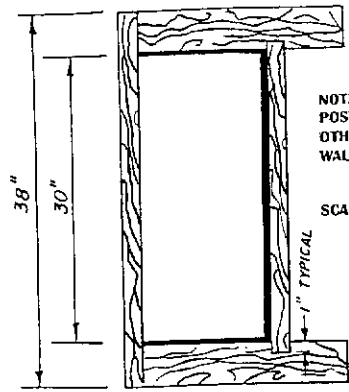


PLAN VIEW

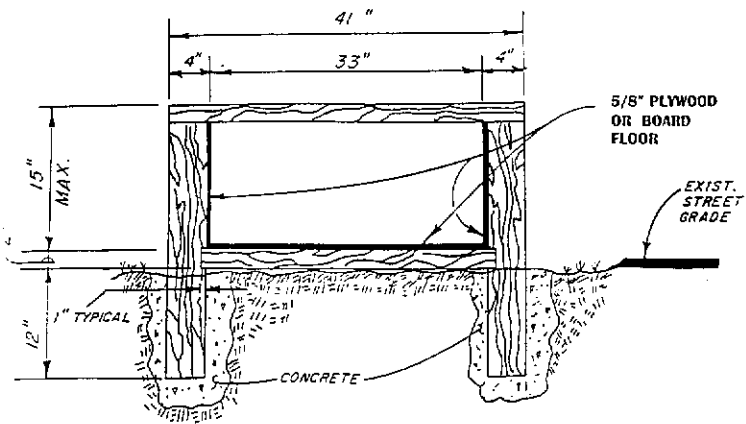


SIDE VIEW

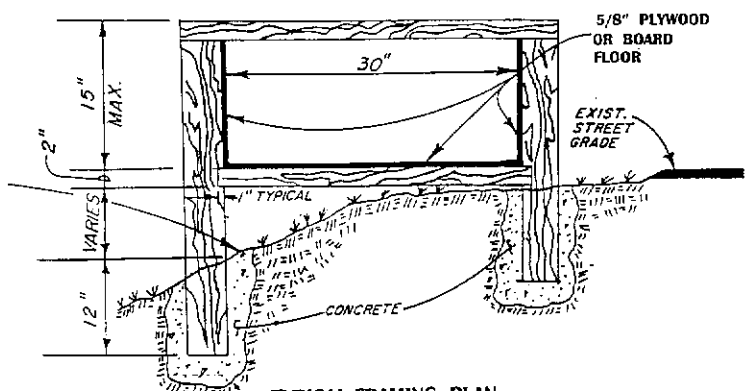
NOTE:

- GUIDELINES**
1. This garbage bin is an option for residents west of 7 1/2 Mile Road, but it is not mandatory by the City.
  2. The top of garbage bin should not be more than 15-inches above the street. This will assure that the truck can pickup the cart at the right location on the container.
  3. The bin should be anchored with cement or each leg may be buried 24-inches deep. This will assure stability of the bin.
  4. The bin is to be set and built directly on the ground and leveled.
  5. The bin should be built 3-feet from the edge of the street
  6. The garbage bin is primarily for the accommodation of property owners that are not full-time residents.
  7. The garbage bin offers minimum protection against winds. If severe weather approaches, carts should be moved/secured.
