From 04/01/19 through 04/30/19 there will be no charge at the Transfer Station for residential customers presenting a current City of Galveston utility bill and a picture i.d. showing they pay for city refuse service. Copies of utility bills will not be accepted. Resident must be present for transfer station drop off. Hours of operation: 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday and 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM Saturday at 5515 Harborside Drive. (Note Saturday hours are being extended for April 6th and April 13, 2019 only).

Please ensure the large bulk piles (or large items requiring the litter truck) are **not** placed under low hanging wires or branches or over your meter. If the items are placed in any of these areas crews will be unable to remove.

Any material not picked up on Friday or Saturday will be picked up on the regularly scheduled garbage day.

All white goods, including those without freon, may be dropped off at the Recycling Center between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:45 PM Monday through Saturday at 702 61st Street.

A resident may drop off up to five (5) tires without rims at the Recycling Center from 8:00 AM to 4:45 PM at 702 61st Street. Current water bill required.

Small amounts of building and construction material will be picked up. Please check with the Transfer Station at 409-741-1258 to confirm what they will allow to be disposed. The Transfer Station is located at 5515 Harborside Drive.

If you have paint to dispose of, open the can, fill with kitty litter, sand or sawdust and leave the lid off of the can. When it has completely dried up, set the can out without the lid and the city will pick up.

Note: The Transfer Station does **NOT** accept the following items:

- Tires
- Appliances with Freon
- Insecticides
- Batteries
- Liquids of any kind
- Any flammable material
- Paint
- Air conditioners
- Pesticides
- Any material with asbestos
- Fire extinguishers
